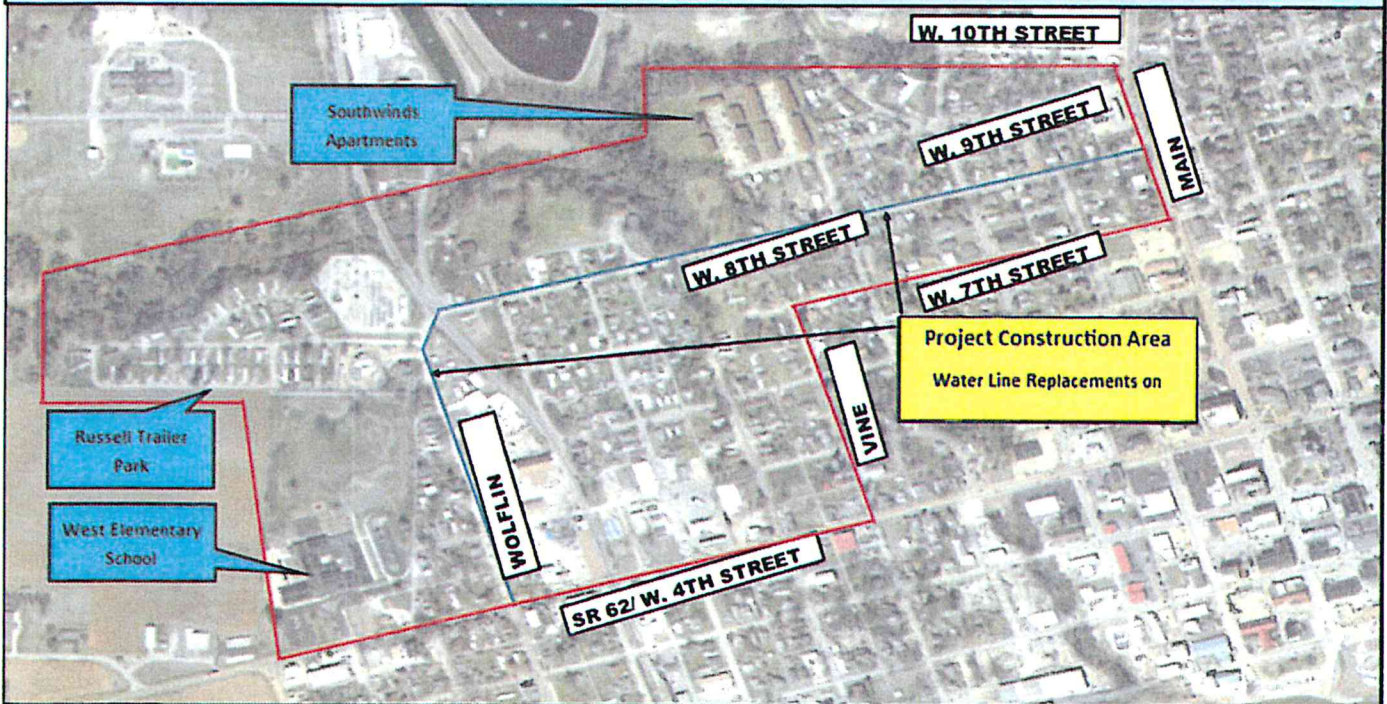


Mount Vernon Northwest Water Improvements Project Map (8th Street & Wolflin Street)

PROJECT DETAILS

- ◆ Total Project Cost = \$1,380,000
 - ◆ \$700,000 in Federal Grant Funding (In Application Process with IOCRA Now)
 - ◆ \$680,000 City Water Improvement Funds
- ◆ Project Area Serves 783 Residents
- ◆ Replace 133 Year Old Corroded Cast Iron Water Mains on W. 8th & Wolflin Streets
- ◆ Install 4,500 Linear Feet of New 8-Inch Heavy Duty PVC Water Main on W. 8th Street & Wolflin Street
- ◆ Install 9 New Fire Hydrants (One Every 500 Feet)
- ◆ 10 Reconnections at Street Crossings, 80 Service Line Connections & 20 New Shut-Off Valves

PROJECT OUTCOMES

- ◆ Elimination of Corrosion and Blockages Within Primary Water Mains and Fire Hydrants Servicing the W. 8th Street & Wolflin Street Neighborhood
- ◆ Improved Water Quality
- ◆ Improved Water Pressure & Water Flow
- ◆ Enhanced Fire Fighting Capabilities
- ◆ Elimination of the Threat of Breakages/Leaks Associated with the Age and Condition of the Existing Water Mains
- ◆ Elimination of the Threat of Contamination Within the Water Associated with the Age and Condition of the Existing Water Mains
- ◆ Long-Term Cost Savings to the City Related to Maintenance and Water Loss
